I believe that good architecture is based on knowledge and philosophy, and is the expression of creative thought. A good architect is a creative thinker with a philosophic belief in a certain set of values, and who imposes his tasks upon himself to make every decision according to the goals of his mission. And so I set myself a task: to be modern and yet timeless, making beautiful spaces and buildings with forms that go beyond the fashions of time and ephemeral images.

In my work, the presence of ancient archetypes and natural materials are reinvented through the process of creative thinking, and are intertwined with the demands of modern living. These archetypes travel intact through time and far beyond it: they are constantly present in our souls.

Commonly seen above all in my projects is a love of natural elements – air, space, light, fire, water and earth. This is combined with the presence of clear geometry, elegant configurations, a tension between the abstract and the earthy, and a feeling of stability, calm and simplicity, though never in a banal sense. A good architect must never abandon his or her creative thinking.
