SYNOPSIS

All professionals would do well to manage their exposure to risks in the course of performing their professional duties. 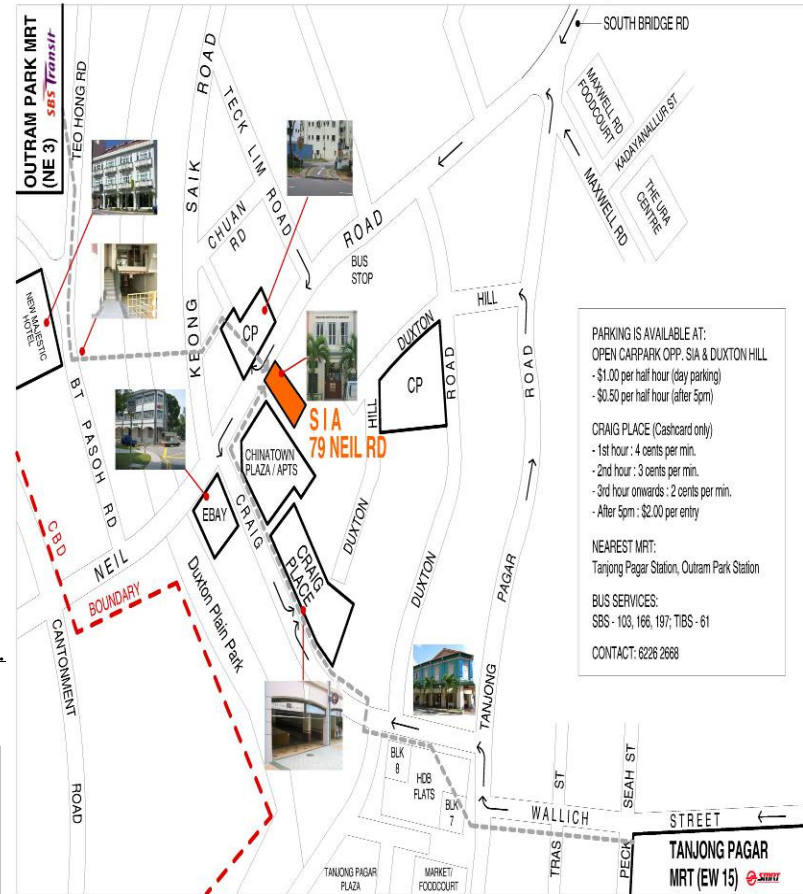
