

## **SINGAPORE INSTITUTE OF ARCHITECTS PANEL OF MEDIATORS**

### **Criteria for listing on the SIA Panel of Mediators**

- (1) Applicant shall have at least 10 years' experience in professional architectural practice after attaining registration with Board of Architects, Singapore, **AND**;
- (2) Applicant shall be a fully paid-up Corporate or Fellow Member (including of the retired variety) or Life Member of SIA, **AND**;
- (3) Applicants shall have relevant experience and qualifications in mediation

The following criteria apply for admission and renewal (every 3 years) to the SIA Panel of Mediators:

(A) Admission to the Panel requires Formal Training in mediation (involving a course by a recognised mediation body\*, with a formal assessment of competency) within the last three (3) years.

(B) Renewal to the Panel requires continuous application of mediation skills in the immediate past three (3) years since admission (or the last renewal, as the case may be), through either (i) relevant & recent experience (at least one case of mediation of a commercial matter) or (ii) participation for a total of at least 10 hours in a continuous education or training / development programme conducted by a recognised mediation body\*.

\*The term "recognised mediation body" means an organisation that is recognised by way of legislation, government accreditation, incorporation or society registration as having as an object the training and continuous development of mediators appropriate for mediation of disputes of a commercial nature.

Note: The SIA President retains final discretion in the admission, retention and renewal of mediators to the Panel.
