Nature, Nurture; Local, Global – a Singapore Perspective

Synopsis:

This paper comes in three parts. The first describes the experience and achievements of urbanization in Singapore. The key characteristics lie in its speed, quality and comprehensiveness in the plan and implementation. The second part discusses the key consideration in the preparation and implementation of the plan. The key tenet is that urbanization is not a pure technical matter. It is intimately linked to the value judgement and cultural propensity of the planners and the society. The final part attempts to analyze the critical success factors of the Singapore experience and its relevance to other cities. While the Singapore story presents many useful examples for cities of similar to emulate, when it comes to bigger cities, a bolder approach referred to as Constellation City, is required to tackle the more demanding needs.

C. V. of Speaker

Dr Liu Thai Ker, director of Singapore's RSP Architects Planners & Engineers (Pte) Ltd, Chairman of the National Arts Council and Adjunct Professor of School of Design and Environment, National University of Singapore. Dr Liu was formerly the Chief Executive Officer of the Housing

& Development Board (1969 – 1989) where he saw the completion of over half a million dwelling units. From 1989 to 1992, he was the Chief Executive Officer and Chief Planner of the new Urban Redevelopment Authority who spearhead the major revision of the Singapore Concept Plan in 1991.
