## SYNOPSIS

### Termguard Reticulated Termite Retreatment Systems

With the banning of organochlorines and subsequent introduction of environmentally friendly termite control agents in 1995. Termguard developed a range of reticulation options to meet the needs of the building industry.

The Termguard Reticulated Termite Retreatment Systems consist of a central high quality manifold with perforated piping installed to the external perimeter, the internal construction joints and establishes a protection around the plumbing penetrations, with pump-up point and child proof trap. The system when fully installed and charged with termiticide creates a total Underslab Termite Management System warranted for **50** years.

The Termguard Reticulated Termite Retreatment Systems enable initial and re-application of environmentally compatible termite management agents under and around the building construction which are inaccessible following the completion of construction. It eradicates problems associated with termiticide drift and exposures that are harmful to people, animals and environment and eliminates exposure or barrier disruption by building workers.

This seminar covers the introduction to the various termguard systems, the benefits and effectiveness of the systems and termguard projects in Singapore.
