The Building and Construction Industry Security of Payment Act 2004 ("SOP Act") came into force on 1st April 2005. The SOP Act has introduced new changes to the Construction Industry. Among other things, it now enables the Contractor, Supplier and Construction Professionals to seek speedy payment of their progress claims and to refer such claims to adjudication instead of to the Courts and arbitration in the event of non payment. This has a made a deep impact on the manner of presentation of claims and the response to such claims.

New terms such as "payment claim, "payment response and "adjudication" are introduced in the SOP Act. As a result of the SOP Act the standard forms of building contracts including the PSSCOC and the SIA Conditions of Main and Sub Contract were amended to ensure compliance with the SOP Act.

In this Seminar, the main provisions of the SOP Act will be discussed, including terms such as the payment claim and the payment response, the process of adjudication and the amendments of the SIA Conditions of Main Contract and Conditions of Sub Contract arising from the SOP Act.

Mr Raymond Chan is Advocate and Solicitor of the Supreme Court of Singapore, Director of TSMP Law Corporation, Honorary Legal Adviser to the Real Estate Developer's Association of Singapore ("REDAS") and the Singapore Institute of Architects ("SIA").
