synopsis

The seminar will address the specification and selection of ceramic tiles with reference to SS 483 and ISO 13006 including misconceptions and confusions within the specifications and standards. Examples of common tiling failures will also be covered relating back to the code. Often, the performance of a ceramic tiling system does not depend on the characteristic of the ceramic tiles alone as it is affected as much by the bedding and substrate. The incompatibility of the various layers within the composite system will also be discussed.
