The talk will evaluate and analyze the experiences obtained to-date in conserving Singapore's heritage buildings and their environment. In addition, the speaker will provide views and suggestions to further enhance their cultural values and their adaptive re-use in a more sustainable manner.

A panel consisting of members from various conservation-related associations (National Heritage Board, Urban Redevelopment Authority, Singapore Heritage Society, Singapore Institute of Architects, etc) will be invited to have a discourse of the points raised up by the speaker.
