SYNOPSIS

"The floor area of construction in Southeast Asia in the first quarter 2007 increased 60% on a year earlier. Total floor area leapt to 57 billion square meters from 36 billion square meters a year earlier. Meanwhile, the growth rate for Greater China (including Hong Kong and Macau) was 37% in comparison for the same period. The total floor area of projects increased to 301 billion square meters, up from 220 billion square meters in the first quarter last year. The enormous figures and growth rate, together with today's communication tools and globalised competition, have presented altogether an unprecedented environment for young design practices in Asia. To emerge, it requires certain unique approaches and attitudes different from the previous generations."

In this Designer's Forum, we will discover specific approaches and thoughts in relation to the current architecture development in Asia. Each Designer's Forum will present 3-4 speakers from a range of designers, academia and multi-discipline collaborations. A vibrant dialogue and life interaction is expected to arise from the panel and audiences.
