SYNOPSIS

To reduce WSH risks during the construction and maintenance phases of the construction process, architects and designers should work with contractors and other stakeholders to identify potential construction and maintenance hazards, and mitigate risks at the design stage.

This presentation provides an overview of the practices in design safety of developed countries, such as United Kingdom, Australia and USA. It also looks at how design safety can be implemented in the construction industry to enhance WSH and reduce accidents in the construction industry.

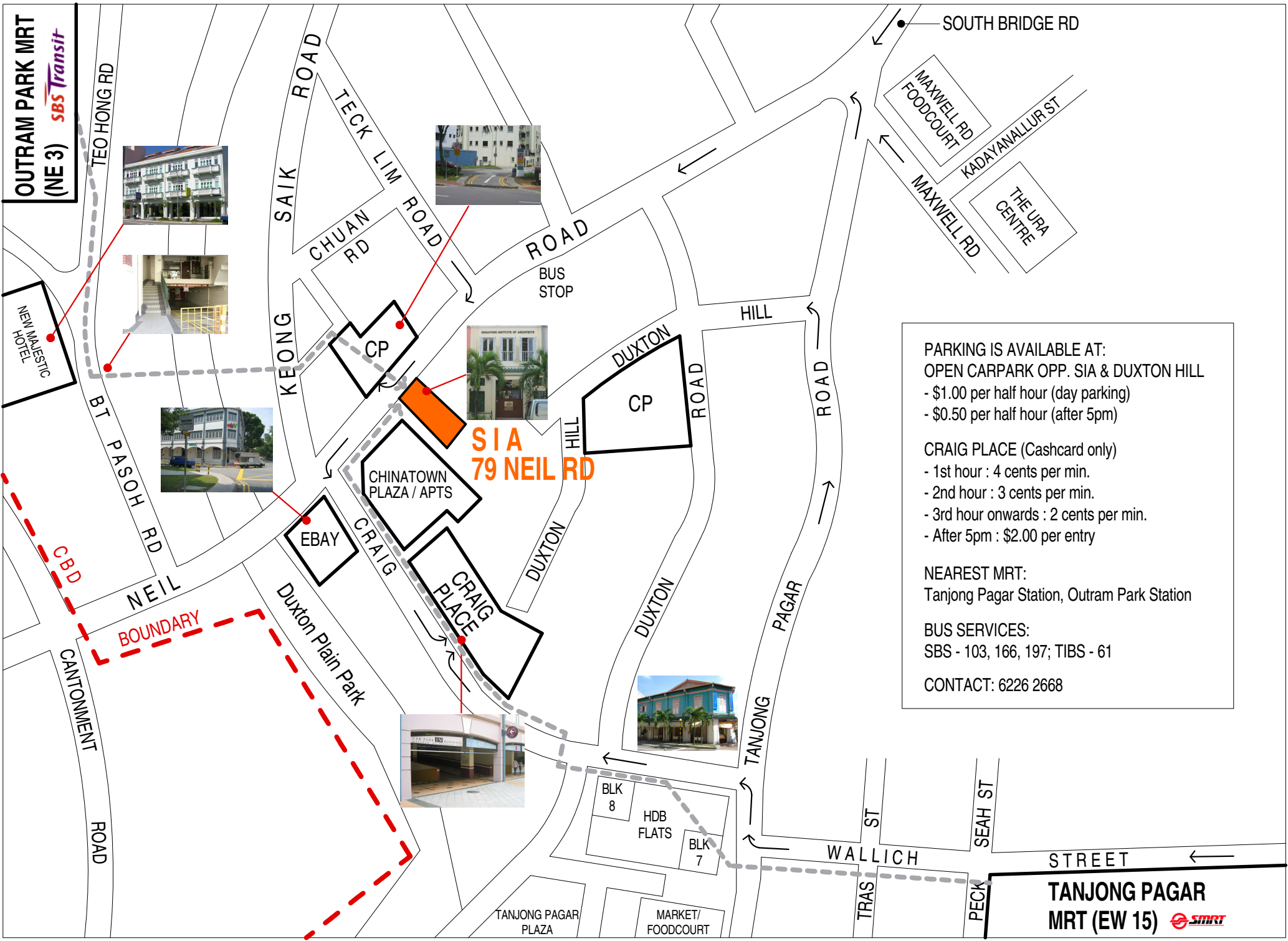
