SPEAKER'S PROFILE

Dato Dr Ken Yeang - Ken Yeang is an architect-planner, and one of the foremost ecodesigners, theoreticians and thinkers in the field of green design. After studying architecture at the Architectural Association in London, his work on the green agenda started in the 70s beginning with his doctoral dissertation for the University of Cambridge on ecological design and planning.

Ken Yeang is the author of several books on ecological design, including The Skyscraper, Bioclimatically Considered: A Design Primer (1996) published by Wiley-Academy, and The Green Skyscraper: The Basis for Designing Sustainable Intensive Buildings (1999) published by Prestel (Germany). He is the distinguished Plym Professor at the University of Illinois (USA) and Adjunct Professor at the University of Malaya (Malaysia), University of Tongji (China) and University of Hawaii (USA), and recently received a D. Lit. (Hon) from the University of Sheffield (UK).

He is a Fellow of the Singapore Institute of Architects, Honorary FAIA and has served on the RIBA Council. A principal of Llewelyn Davies Yeang (UK) and its sister firm, Hamzah & Yeang (Malaysia), Ken Yeang is well known for designing innovative signature green buildings and masterplans, and for his pursuit of the ecological aesthetic in his designs.
