Jean-Francois Milou, lead partner of StudioMilou architecture and chief architect for the National Art Gallery of Singapore, is a graduate of the Ecole Nationale Supérieure des Beaux-Arts in Paris, where he qualified as an architect. He leads a team of full-time architects working at StudioMilou architecture, as well as directing the work of permanent consultants and associated staff working on StudioMilou projects in France and elsewhere.

In addition to his architectural work, Jean-Francois Milou has worked as a consultant for UNESCO and for the French Government on projects in India, Nepal, Indonesia and Georgia.

His work, like the work of the firm he leads, reflects a deeply held belief in simple, legible design using appropriate materials and respecting both the fabric of existing buildings and the architectural and urban setting.
