



The Green Plot Ratio (GnPR) [2003] aims to provide an ecological measure for architecture and urban planning. JTC, HDB & BCA has adopted it as a tool to encourage more greenery in sustainable projects. However, further investigation into GnPR has highlighted some problems- it is insensitive to plant species and Leaf Area Index (LAI) values varies. Framed as an open ended discussion, the presentation reviews and reflects upon the work carried out in implementation of the GnPR.



Green architecture is often hyped up so much that it is in danger of becoming a style rather than a fundamental set of attitudes architects should have at any age. This presentation looks at the very basic and simple approaches that have been taken by architects working in Sri Lanka, to achieve an environmentally sustainable architecture without resorting to too much technology.



Shades of Green describes the evolution of work that emerges from responding to changing needs of our world. From the early years of our practice, architectural response to energy issues has been encapsulated holistically but never the dominating factor to replace the response to Space + Context. The Energy dynamics resulting in what terms Shades of Green becomes the backbone, but not necessarily the dominant expression. The architectural response is holistic & dynamic in maintaining Space+Context as the primary driver to the architectural expression of Hijjas Kasturi Associates.
