The year before, Colin was nominated for the MARCUS CORPORATION FOUNDATION PRIZE 2007 as an *emerging architect with potential for greatness*. The same year, he was recognized as an ARENA + LOUIS VUITTON BLACK COLLAR MAN OF THE YEAR for his contributions as a spatial designer.

The choice of locating a void at the 5th level is a fantastic idea; it provides a commanding view of the Singapore river. This sky terrace reflected the "blue and green" from the river in its artful integration of indoor and outdoor landscape.
