Introduction: The Tiling System

A tiling finish is a system comprising no less than substrate, bedding, ceramic tiles (or stone veneers), grout and movement joints. All components are equally important and intimately related to one another. Adequate compatibility must exist among the components as they could only function collectively. The system could only be as strong as the weakest component.

SYNOPSIS

Talk will focus on:

Different Types of Adhesives Available in the Market

- Cementitious (C): 1 component mixed with water only
- Cementitious (C): 2 component Part A Powder + Part B Liquid
- Dispersion (D): 1 part ready-to-use paste (no mixing required)
- Reaction Resin (D): Mixture of synthetic resin, mineral fillers and organic additives. Hardening process occurs by chemical reaction; typically resin-based epoxies and polyurethane products

How are the Different Types of Adhesives classified in accordance to Standards:

Classification of adhesives will be based on Adhesive Type; C, D or R - Normal Performance vs Improved Performance.

Performance criteria for each type - Refer to Standards of BS EN 12004 (European Norm) and ISO 13007-1: Fundamental Characteristics and Special Additional Characteristics of Deformable Adhesives, Fast-setting adhesives etc.

Common Complaints & How to Avoid It

We will review common complaints and discuss on how some of these complaints can be avoided eg., Adhesive's Open Time, Substrate condition & preparation, Shelter & Protection from Direct Sunlight and Rain for Outdoor Applications and Swimming Pool etc.

In summary, this technical talk will increase the awareness on the understanding of the different performance levels of adhesives for various applications and selecting the right adhesive with due consideration to budget and performance.
