Ole Scheeren is an internationally acclaimed architect and partner along with Rem Koolhaas in the firm of Office for Metropolitan Architecture (OMA). Scheeren is director of OMA Rotterdam and OMA Beijing and in charge of the firm's work across Asia. As partner-in-charge of OMA's largest project to date, he led design and construction of the China Central Television Station (CCTV) and the Television Cultural Center (TVCC) in Beijing. His current projects include: MahaNakhon in Bangkok; 2 residential projects in Singapore; a media center in Shanghai; the Taipei Performing Arts Centre in Taiwan and the New City Center for Shenzhen, amongst others.

As a follow up to his Asia Agenda lecture given in 2007, Scheeren returns to Singapore to talk about his current work and continued engagement in Asia. The dynamic relationships between architecture, nature, community, public and private spaces, situated in the tropical context, will be discussed and presented.
