Kenneth Yeang: DESIGN & COMPETITIONS



Dr. Ken Yeang is an architect-planner, ecologist and author who is best known for his signature and innovative green buildings and masterplans. He is regarded as one of the foremost designers and noted authority on ecologically-responsive architecture and planning. He has authored several books on ecological design and tall building design. His latest is, *Ecodesign: Manual for Ecological Design*, published by John Wiley & Sons (UK). He has pioneered the passive low-energy design of tall buildings, which he calls the 'bioclimatic skyscraper'. He has received numerous awards for his work and designs that include the Aga Khan Award for Architecture, RAI International Award, Prinz Claus Award, UIA August Perret Award. His key built works include the Menara Mesiniaga tower (Malaysia), the National Library (Singapore) Great Ormond Street Hospital Extension (UK). He is an Honorary Fellow of the American Institute of Architects, past Chairman of ARCASIA and has served on the Royal Institute of Architects Council. He is the distinguished Plym Professor at the University of Illinois, and Adjunct Professors at the University of Hawaii and University of Malaya. He is a principal of the UK architect and planning firm, Llewelyn Davies Yeang and its sister company, Hamzah & Yeang (Malaysia).

Doing Architectural Competitions

The lecture presents an approach to doing architectural and masterplan competitions. Each architect will have his/her own strategy and approach to handling design competitions.

The lecture presents a method of work to doing and controlling the process: agreeing on the fee, resourcing and conceptualisation and making the scheme work, the delivery process, scheduling, budgeting, etc.. Like a normal project, the competition work ends not with the submission and handling the interview to the jury, but with the completion of the Final Accounts of the expenses incurred showing profit or loss, and the archiving of the competition material and preparation of material in the event of future publication.
