The Sustainable Built Environment will focus on:

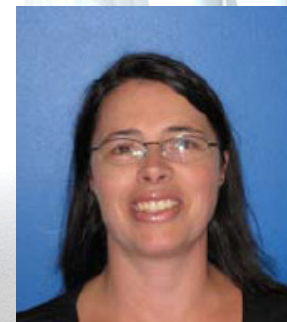
- Raw Material Extraction

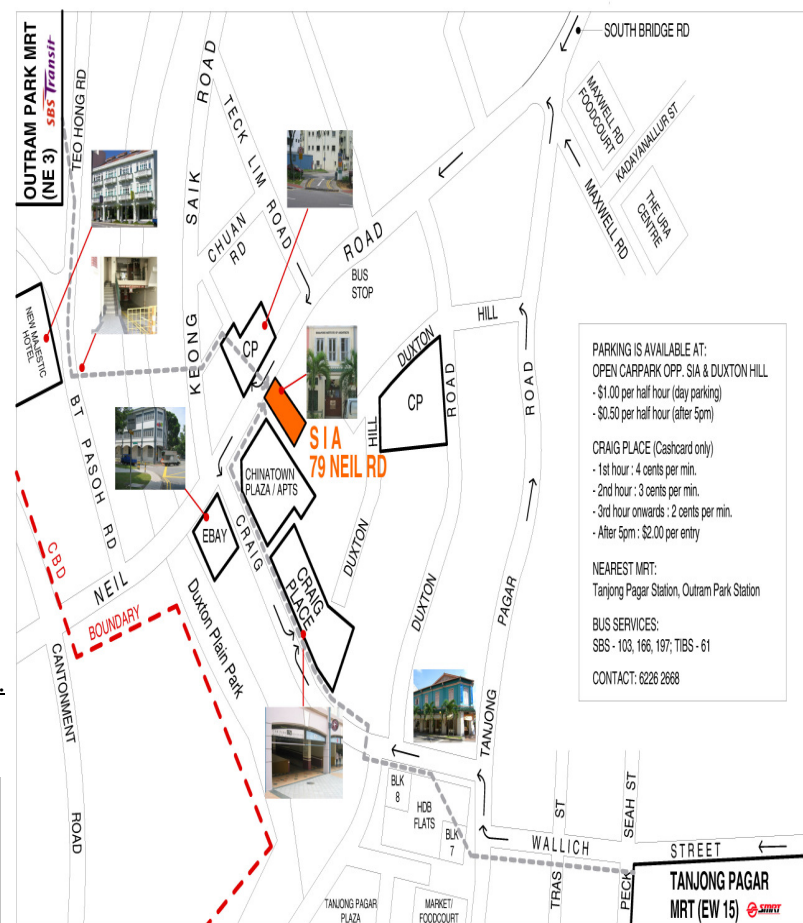
