Both the Gallery Hotel (in collaboration with William Lim Associates Pte) and Eastpoint (in collaboration with Team design Architects) were nominated for The



Aga Khan Award for Architecture (2001 Award Cycle). Nominee for Innovative Architecture, UIA, Istanbul (Gold Medal & Other Prizes). The 4th recipient of SIA Gold Medal Award 2006 and The Golden Award for Excellence in Architecture-Singapore by a+d and Spectrum Foundation in 2009.

He has contributed significantly to the Department of Architecture, NUS as external examiner and visiting critic, and served as member on the Board of Architects and council member of Singapore Institute of Architects. He is currently also a Committee Member of NAFA Fine Art Curriculum Development Advisory Committee.
