#### SPEAKERS PROFILE

#### Khoo Peng Beng

Khoo Peng Beng founded his architectural practice Arc Studio with his wife Belinda in 1998. They beat over two hundred firms from all over the world to clinch the Duxton Plain Public Housing International Architectural Design Competitions top prize by presenting a scheme that resolved complex issues in a simple and elegant manner.

Peng Beng is a Council Member in the Singapore Institute of Architects involved in the education. He was the Lead Curator for the Singapore Pavilion in the 6th International Biennial of Architecture and Design in 2005. Peng Beng served in the Urban Redevelopment Authority (URA) Design Advisory Committee between 2002 and 2004 and is now in the Architectural Design Review Committee for the Housing Development Board. He is a tutor at the National University of Singapore and lectured in the Singapore Polytechnic. Peng Beng has delivered keynote addresses and conference papers at the 18th EAROPH World Planning Congress, Batimat Asia and numerous other forums and conferences. Peng Beng believes in spreading the magic of design thinking and has facilitated numerous workshops and talks to ignite the creative spark of the young.

#### Mark Wee

Mark Wee is the Principle Director of ANNEX A Architects, the architectural arm of UNION Experience Pte Ltd. The firm is committed to designing beautiful and thoughtful environments through understanding context and user needs. In 2008, his team was selected as 1 0f 10 local architectural firms to represent Singapore for the 12th Venice Architectural Biennale.

Mark sits on the Singapore Institute of Architects Council where he chairs The Architectural League. He has lectured and taught in academic institutions locally and overseas. Mark studied architecture at Cornell University.

#### Lim Choon Keang

Lim Choon Keang is the Senior Vice President (Architecture) of CPG Consultants Pte Ltd. He is a Council Member in the Singapore Institute of Architects (SIA). He also served as the Chairman in the Development Control Sub-Committee, Deputy Chairman of the RCS Committee and Member of the Practice Convention Organising Committee 2009/2010. He represented SIA in the Environment Sub-Committee, URA DCD - SIA/SIP/REDAS/ACES Dialogue and Review of Long Slab Blocks. Choon Keang studied architecture and project management in the National University of Singapore.




