**Mr. Jeffrey Allan**

BA Hons Dip Arch BRS, GMM, RIBA MSIA

A graduate of Oxford School Architecture with distinctions in both Architecture and Built Resource Studies (Architectural Regeneration and Re-Development) and a Chartered Architect in the UK and Singapore. As a director of AWP Pte Ltd his roles are that of a design and technical director of Architecture, Planning and Environmental Sustainable Design as a Green Mark Manager. Born and currently practicing in Singapore and educated in the UK, Jeffrey is an award winning and published architect with 20 years of experience through projects in Africa, Asia, Middle East and UK. His portfolio of work based upon a modernity of methodology consists of diverse Public and Private sector commissions ranging in scale from Town Planning to Architecture and Interior Design.

### Judges' Citation - Edwards Lifescience Manufacturing Facility

This work presents an unusual solution for a potentially very functional building. The Jury enjoyed the architect's use of the sun-shading device to create a pattern resembling a cardiogram on the façade. The layout of the building resulted from the client's philosophy of a facility that is universally accessible to promote understanding of what they do. This is cleverly reflected by the placement of the public and office areas at the front, while the enclosed and controlled production areas are at the rear of the building. The layout enables visitors to learn about the history, products and new developments of the company, placed along the interactive museum ramp leading to the heart valve assembly room. The jury commends the architect for the innovative approach to the design of such a facility and also the Client for accepting this unusual design.

### Mr. Mohd Asaduz Zaman

He has immense knowledge on experience in his work as Architect for 29 years since 1974. He has been the designer for many renowned Housing, Commercial & Mosque projects for HDB Towns as a Design Studio Head in Housing Development Board of Singapore. With many years of experience as Head of Architectural Design Studio, his strong sense of design is evident in producing award winning designs both in Singapore and overseas, such as FIABCI, SIA Awards. His contribution to Design and Architecture has been very valuable, especially in the projects of Bukit Panjang & Punggol New Town.

### Judges' Citation - 30 Jalan Rukam

The Jury is impressed that the architect is able to make a semi-detached house feel like an individual house. The work has demonstrated it is possible not to fall into the trap of being constrained by pre-conceived typology in design. The 2 buildings create a nice double volume in-between space, which diffuses natural light beautifully. The linked bridge articulates the space as well as connects the buildings.



### PEARL CHEE

Pearl Chee is an associate with WOHA, a regional design practice based in Singapore. She holds a bachelor of Architecture from the School of Architecture, National University of Singapore. Pearl's portfolio with WOHA includes design coordination and project management of a variety of projects including luxury condominium, high density housing and public projects.

### Judges' Citation - Bras Basah Mass Rapid Transit Station, Singapore

The Jury distinguishes this work as an excellent building which stands out from the designs of the other existing rapid transit stations. A unique water pool serves multiple purposes - a reflection pool at the ground level and a skylight for the underground station, a visual graphic installation, visual connection for commuters to the ground etc. This station presents an invigorating and memorable experience to commuters and is an architectural work of the highest order.

### Maria Warner Wong

She is the Design Director and founder of Warner Wong Design and WOW Architects, an international, multi-disciplinary consultancy based in Singapore and founded in the year 2000. Ms Warner Wong is committed to building a world class design services consultancy, based on international standards, providing a unique mix of Asian and International design sensibilities. As a practicing architect with 20 years experience Warner Wong's core strengths lie in design, strategic leadership, and staff development, also providing leadership in the areas of human resource, management, finance and administration as a complement to Design and Design Management.

Maria Warner Wong has a Bachelor of Architecture degree from the University of Southern California and Masters Degree in Architecture from The Graduate School of Design, Harvard University.

### Judges' Citation - Vivanta by Taj (Bangalore ITPB, Whitefield)

This is a very innovative design with an unusual typology for a hotel, especially for one catering to business travellers. Despite the height constraints imposed on the site, this design makes full use of every plane. The architect was inspired by the local culture and had incorporated parts of it into the design, resulting in a building that twists and circles - starting with a podium sitting on the ground, leading to the hotel room block which hovers mid-air and flexes its way around the site. This twisting and circling of the building recalls the moves of traditional Indian dances. The Jury enjoyed the wonder and delight in the spaces of this architecture as the design concept is carried right through to the interior layout and finishes. The Jury wishes to commend the effort put in by the architect in working with the limitation of the local construction practice, where raw finishes and larger tolerances have to be built into the design. The pixilated facade-design was inspired by the landscape the architects saw when they first arrived on the site. This work demonstrates clarity in design intention with well-considered strategies to achieve the vision. The Jury would also like to congratulate the Client for having taken a bold step in accepting this innovative design.

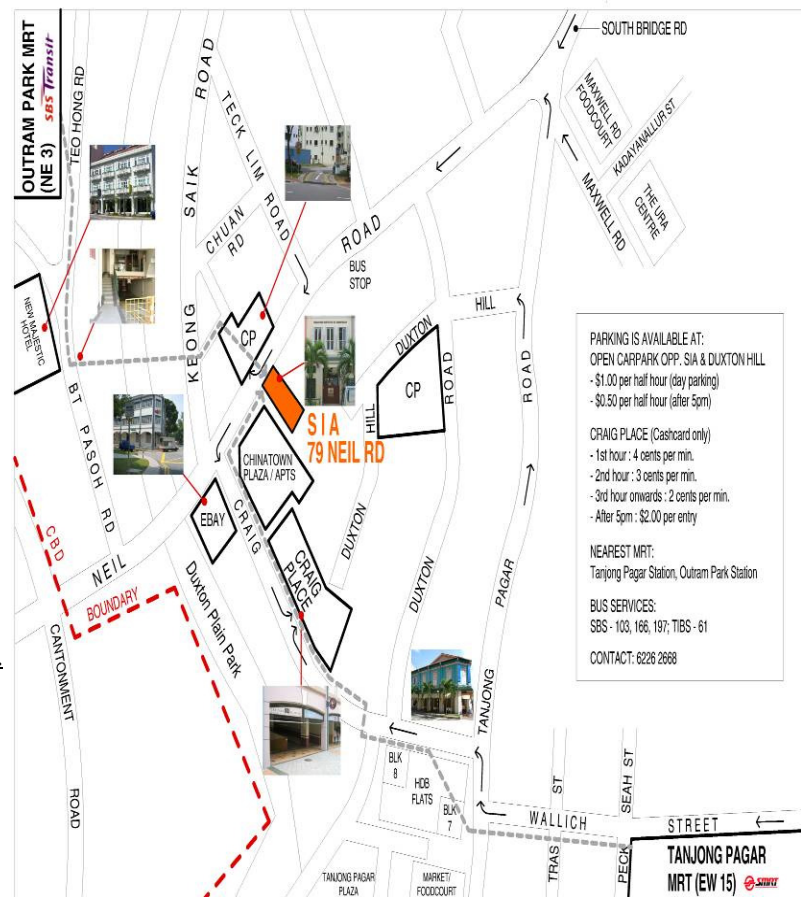
