Warren Liu Yaw Lin

Mr. Liu was a former Associate of DP Architects Pte Ltd. In year 2000, he came out to help set up DLab 3, a small experimental design outfit that focused on cutting edge residential projects that tackle the issues of social and economic transformations within high density urban living conditions. He joined Nikken Sekkei as a Design Principal between 2001-2003. Nikken Sekkei partnership was subsequently dissolved toward the end of 2003 and to facilitate the transition of projects handled by the office, WOW architects was formed with Mr. Liu as one of the founding partners where he also acted as the Design Director of the associated firm Warner Wong Pte. Ltd., which focuses on interior design projects. In 2006, he retired from WOW architects to become precedent partner of a.d_lab pte ltd and d_lab. Mr. Liu has worked on many large and small scale architectural, master planning and interior projects throughout Asia as well as Europe.

Judge's Citation - 8 Lorong Kemunchu

The Jury recognized that the architect is able to handle a very difficult site ingeniously. The challenge is a long, narrow strip behind the original house with an incline of 6 meters. The design of the roof blends in well with the surrounding topography and the creation of several roof decks allows the residents to enjoy the surrounding view at different parts of the house.



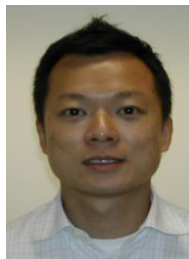
COLIN WU

Colin is presently a Vice President (Architecture) with CPG Consultants Pte Ltd. Over the 15 years with CPG, he has gained valuable experience in designing, implementing and supervising the construction of various public and institutional buildings, from new built to conservation.

He was the Lead Project Architect for the completed \$118m Redevelopment of the Singapore History Museum project, now known as the National Museum of Singapore. The works involved sensitive restoration and conservation of the 119-year-old NM Building, a national monument at Stamford Road and the construction of a totally new contemporary extension block at the rear.

Judge's Citation - National Museum of Singapore

Since 1887, the national museum has undergone 4 major redevelopments. The latest phase doubled the capacity of the museum with an underlying brief to define the program towards national identity and the history of Singapore. The Jury found this extension as a sensitive intervention, where the existing building is beautifully restored the façade, zinc fish-scale tiles, pinnacle terminations, balustrade, spiral staircase, cast-iron columns, decorative grilles and stained glass installations were brought back to life by skilled craftsmen and use of modern construction technology. The extension, housing new galleries, multi-function auditorium, a rotunda-theatre, are harmonious additions in the compound. It is conceived as an urban corridor connecting the historic Fort Canning Hill and Bras Basah Park, and an apt metaphor for a space meant to showcase the past, present and future of the nation.



Chan Mun Kit

Graduated from the School of Architecture, National University of Singapore in 2001, Chan Mun Kit was the recipient of the Board of Architects Gold Medal Award. He joined Architects 61 in 2002 and is currently an Associate Director in the firm specializing on design and design development. Over the 8 years of practice, he was involved in a diversity of notable projects both in Singapore and overseas, particularly in residential and commercial which have produced award winning designs such as SIA Awards and URA Heritage Awards. He is also a registered Architect with the Board of Architects (BOA) in Singapore and a corporate member of the Singapore Institute of Architects.

Judge's Citation - The Cosmopolitan

The building looks like an endearing city landmark because of its simple, beautifully-proportioned and well-composed design. The work looks stunning as a city landmark,

without overdoing it. In particular, the jury is impressed by the articulation and scale of the elevation and the ground floor areas are well integrated with the landscape. There is a lot of honesty in this scheme which shows up the indulgence that often overwhelms the design in many other projects.

Graduated from the School of Architecture, National University of Singapore in 1993, Un Wai Kay is a Senior Associate with Architects 61.

She has over 16 years of experience involved in executing various stages of architectural services from design development to contract administration. She has been involved in a diversity of notable projects both in Singapore and overseas, in hotels, residential, commercial and institutional, which have produced award winning designs such as SIA, FIABCI, URA Heritage and President's Awards. She is a council member of the Architecture Alumni Association, NUS since 2004 and was a Professional Practice Examiner with the Board of Architects from 2005 to 2007.

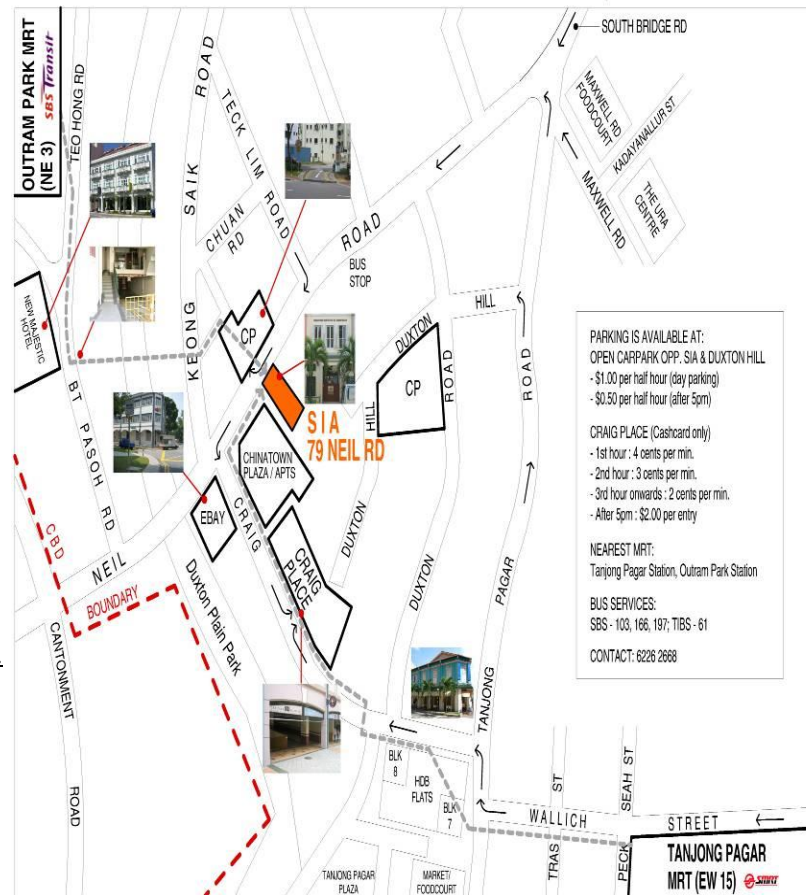
