'Architecture as a Business: Recent Trends'

Whether we like it or not, the practice of architecture is a business There are four aspects in the business of architecture that an architect must do well: Getting the business (marketing), Doing the business (the usual scope of work of the architect as defined by the Institute), Running the Business (General management functions), Financing the business (money management). The architect in practice cannot do just one or a few of these aspects well, he must do all well otherwise his business will falter and worse, fail. These are the key dials on his dashboard. The presentation discusses the latest trends in each of these four aspects.

Dato Dr. Ken Yeang is principal of the architect and planning firm T. R. Hamzah & Yeang Sdn. Bhd. (Malaysia) and Llewelyn Davies Yeang (UK), and was recently named by the Guardian newspaper as one of 50 individuals who could save the planet, as well as the leading architect in ecological design by



CNN. Yeang uses vegetation to create habitats in his buildings as total living systems to make buildings perform as complete ecosystems. He balances between engineering infrastructure and nature in design. He has over 30 years of research, delivered over 200 built projects and authored over 5 books on ecological design. He is regarded as the founder of the innovative green tall building - the 'bioclimatic skyscraper' which champions vertical urban design.
