SYNOPSIS

PROGRAMME

The project architect has sometimes been asked to be both a witness of fact as well as an expert witness when a dispute arises within the project. The seminar will discuss the interesting topic of the architect as an expert witness in the dispute resolution process.

Johnny Tan will examine the role, duties and responsibilities of the expert witness. The code of practice that is expected of an expert witness. He will also examine recent case laws on the public policy granting immunity of the expert witness and whether the immunity is under threat arising from recent judgments by the English courts – Phillips v Symes (No.2) [2004] EWHC 2330 (Ch); Stanton v Callaghan [2000] 1 QB 75; Jones v Kaney [2010] EWHC 61 (QB)

John Chung will then discuss who is an expert, the qualifications of the expert, selection of the expert, his appointment and remuneration, and his role in the court and arbitration. In the presentation, John will look at the three stages in the use of expert witness in the dispute resolution process – namely the selection and appointment of the expert, the use of the expert before the hearing and the use of the expert at the hearing.

In the Singapore Institute of Architects, he held the posts of Honorary Secretary, 2nd Vice-President and 1st Vice-President between 1995 and 2000. He has also held several positions in the Singapore Institute of Arbitrators and has been its President since 2007. Johnny is one of the founding committee members of the Society of Construction Law (Singapore).

A firm believer in the value of education, Johnny has been a part-time lecturer in Legal and Contractual Studies for the Honours and Master of Architecture degrees at the National University of Singapore and was a visiting lecturer for the joint Masters of Science Construction Law and Dispute Resolution of the National University of Singapore and King's College, London. He has conducted tutorials for architects taking the BOA Professional Practice Examination since 1997. He also sits on the Board of Governors, Singapore Polytechnic.

John practiced as an architect for 10 years before qualifying as a lawyer in 1991. During his practice as an architect, he had designed and supervised various building types including commercial, industrial, recreational and residential developments. He specialises in construction and engineering law pertaining to various sectors of the industry and his practice ranges from conducting legal actions and proceedings for contract and related disputes in building projects to multi-disciplinary advisory work involving energy, planning, engineering and infrastructure projects in Singapore, Malaysia, Thailand, Vietnam and Africa. He has been involved in front-end contract/advisory work to back-end dispute resolution work involving litigation and arbitrations in Singapore and the region.

John sits as an arbitrator in numerous construction and engineering disputes and has been appointed as sole arbitrator by the Singapore International Arbitration Centre (SIAC) in several cases. He is also an adviser to the Singapore Institute of Architects (SIA) and is a member of its Alternative Dispute Resolution Committee and on the SIA Panel of Arbitrators.
