SYNOPSIS

CPD PROGRAMME

The Productivity and Innovation Credit (PIC) scheme was first introduced in Budget 2010 and further enhanced in Budget 2011.

The PIC scheme provides tax benefits for businesses that are investing in productivity improvements. Businesses can enjoy deduction / allowances at 400%, or receive up to \$30,000 of cash payout. The tax benefits under PIC will be effective from Year of Assessment (YA) 2011 to YA 2015.

The six activities that will qualify for PIC benefits are:

- 1. Acquisition or lease of prescribed automation equipment;
- 2 Training of employees;
- 3. Acquisition of intellectual property (IP);
- 4. Registration of IP;
- 5. Conduct of research of development (R&D) activities;
- 6. Conduct of approved design activities.

This seminar is specially designed to help participants understand how businesses can benefit from the PIC scheme and other tax initiatives introduced during the Singapore Budget 2011, which include:

- 1. Corporate Income Tax Rebate and SME Cash Grant
- 2. Pre-Commencement Expenses for Businesses
- 3. Tax Deduction on Donations
- 4. Foreign Tax Credit (FTC) Pooling System
