Synopsis:

DETERMINE THE NEED OF M&S SYSTEMS IN BUILDINGS

With the release of the circular from FSSD in Jan 2010, a clearer delineation of responsibility between the two disciplines -- the RIs (Arch) and RIs (M&E) has been defined. Among other things, determination of the need of M&E system, such as provision of sprinkler protection system, smoke purging system vis-à-vis engineering smoke control , two way vise / one way communication system, lies on QP architect . And whether or not the M&E systems are provided on site is to be checked and confirmed by RI(Arch). Full understanding of the provision requirement of M&E system is therefore important.
