After graduation from Tokyo University and Nagoya Institute of Technology, Vo returned to Vietnam and created an energysaving architectural style through using environmentally - friendly materials and architectural design.

Vo's works received high appraisals in Vietnam & overseas, and honorable prizes include International Architecture Award (IAA) and Architectural Review Award (AR). Seminal works include wNw Café (2006), wNw Bar (2008) and Bamboo wing (2009). In 2006, Vo started his own architectural firm, Votrongnghia Co., Ltd in Vietnam. Alongside his practice, Nghia has been invited to lecture in several foreign countries such as China, Japan and Sri Lanka.

We need to find a new vocabulary of architecture for tropical climate (e.g. to use natural

energies such as wind & sunshine) to move towards sustainable architecture. We need to pursue use of environmental-friendly materials & rapid growing material like bamboo, and to combine architecture and greenery- the anchor of our people in the tropics. 
