Daniel Korb's collaboration with renowned American furniture manufacturer, Herman Miller resulted in the multi award winning "Sense", a systems approach to tables for the office or home office that require no tools to build or change.

Daniel Korb will explore the term 'MEANINGFUL SPACES' by sharing his working experience in both fields of architecture and furniture design. How to harmonize the many relationships from space, to the objects in the space will be the focus of this seminar. Ultimately Daniel's message is, "furniture is architecture on a different scale" and that "simple is better than complex".

This seminar is targeted to architects, interior designers, furniture designers and related industry players who would like to gain insights in the field of architecture, product design and communication.

### The Speaker - Mr. Daniel Korb

Like many leading designers of modern office furniture, Daniel Korb started as an architect. Since then, his design expertise has broadened and his inspiration refined. Korb + Korb is synonymous with simple and intuitive design. It's this thinking that attracted the attention of Herman Miller and led to the desking system aptly named "Sense". "Sense" is based on simple, spacious work tables. Assembling all products in the line is effortless; parts snap; twist; and lock into place, no tools required.

Sense's efficient design and European sensibilities makes it a strong performer in a variety of environments and has yielded twenty-plus national and international design awards. Among them are the 2009 Australian International Design Award, 2009 IDEA International Design Excellence Awards (Finalist) and 2008 Reddot Design Award (Produkt Design).
