Highlights of Major Transport Projects/Activities



Guangzhou Knowledge City – The third large-scale project between Singapore and China after the Suzhou Industrial Park and Tianjin Eco-City, with a site area of 123 square kilometers. The concept of environmental-friendly transportation and eco-friendly and low-carbon development are being promoted.

Seminar on Developing A People-Centered Green Transport System—Concept and Practices of China and Singapore (打造以人为本的绿色交通系统—中国和新加坡的理念和实践) — The first joint seminar by LTA Academy and Guangzhou Development District at the Guangzhou Knowledge City. This seminar will provide a platform for knowledge sharing and the exchange of best practices and ideas on green transport initiatives and development. There will also be excellent networking opportunities with senior Chinese officials especially during the Opening Ceremony and Gala Dinner.

Guangzhou BRT – The latest and newest BRT (Bus Rapid Transit) system in China, with a length of 23km. It has some 1000 buses operating on 31 routes; carrying close to 1 million passengers a day.

Guangzhou-Shenzhen High Speed Train (广深高铁) and Shenzhen North Railway Station (深圳北站)—

The newly open Guangzhou-Shenzhen special passenger line starts from Guangzhou South Station and forms part of the future Beijing-Hong Kong high-speed railway. Operating at a maximum speed of 300km/hour, it takes only 28 minutes to shuttle between Guangzhou and Shenzhen. The Shenzhen North Station, with 11 platforms and 20 lines, is a mega transport hub in Southern China.





Shenzhen Port (深圳港) is one of the busiest and fastest growing ports in southern mainland China. Located in the southern region of the Pearl River Delta in China's Guangdong province, it is the economic hinterland for Hong Kong trade with the Mainland and also one of the most important ports in terms of China's international trade. The port is home to 39 shipping companies whom have launched 131 international container routes.

Guangzhou Nan Sha Development District (广州南沙 开发区) is being developed to be a hub of heavy, hitech and cargo transportation industries in a matter of several years. "Nansha will by its development further stress its leading position among regional economies and promote the development of the whole South China economy" said Chen Guanghan, director of an economic research center.

Networking Golf Game at Mission Hills Golf Club (观 澜湖会所) — Whole day networking golf will be arranged at Mission Hills Golf Club, which is China's highest rated golf and leisure resort, and the world's largest golf club according to the Guinness World Records. Winner of multiple international awards, the 20-square kilometre golf complex features twelve 18-hole resort and championship courses designed by golf's greatest legends and architects. Mission Hills is the cradle of golf in China and hosts the region's most important tournaments, including the World Cup of Golf and the Asian Amateur Championship.
