# **SIA Expert Determination Training Course**

## SYNOPSIS

Expert Determination is a useful and cost-effective tool for resolving certain kinds of construction disputes, in particular specific technical engineering and construction issues or questions relating to defects or compliance with technical specifications. It can be an effective dispute resolution mechanism for construction and complement as well as support the current Alternate Dispute Resolutions regime.

There will be 2 day training course to equip participants with principles and practices of the SIA Expert Determination Rules. This training course will touch on discussion on Terms of Reference, in particular, Terms of Reference for on-going contracts, how to review evidences and techniques for drafting Expert Determination Decision. The course entails participants working on an independent assessment of a test case and submit their Decisions.

Participants who have passed the training will be eligible for admission to the SIA Panel of Expert Determinators.

### TRAINERS

**Mr Naresh Mahtani**, FCiArb, FSiArb, has been in active legal practice for 28 years in regional and international construction projects, oil and gas projects, commercial transactions and dispute resolution, as counsel as well as arbitrator and adjudicator in various cases in Singapore and the region (including India, Indonesia, Malaysia and Brunei).

He is a founding partner of ATMD Bird & Bird LLP, at which firm he is now a practising consultant for projects and dispute resolution. He was the former Chairman of the Society of Construction Law, Singapore (2006-2008) and has served as council member on the Singapore Institute of Arbitrators and as CEO of the Law Society of Singapore for several years. Amongst various appointments relating to dispute resolution, he has been appointed as arbitrator in SIAC and ICC cases; and is on the Disputes & Compensation Resolution Panel of Singapore Wholesale Electricity Market; adjudicator in the Financial Industry Dispute Resolution Panel (Fldrec) as well as an accredited Adjudicator with the Singapore Mediation Centre. He was engaged by the Singapore Institute of Architects as draftsman of the new Rules for Expert Determination. He writes and speaks regularly at seminars relating to arbitrations and dispute resolution in the construction industry.

**Dr Philip Chan**, an Associate Professor, had received training and practised in the area of quantity surveying in the 70s and 80s. He then read law and qualified as an English barrister and a Singapore advocate and solicitor in the 80s. After a short stint as a legal officer at HDB and a legal assistant at Donaldson and Burkinshaw, he taught Business Law briefly at Ngee Ann Polytechnic and joined the Department of Building, NUS, in 1991. Since then he had taught in several modules that cover the laws and practice in the construction industry.

Dr Chan currently teaches Project Management Law at the MSc (Project management) programme which includes construction law and arbitration; Contract and Procurement Management, and Project Dispute Management in the BSc (Project and Facilities management) programme at the Department of Building, School of Design and Environment, National University of Singapore [NUS].

He is the Programme Director of the Joint King's College, London [KCL] - NUS MSc in construction law and dispute resolution and the Co-Director of the Centre for Project Management and Construction Law. Outside the university, Dr Chan is a Deputy President of the Singapore Strata Titles Board and a member of the Council of Estate Agents Board of Appeal. He is also a Co-Editor of the Asian International Arbitration Journal and a member of the Editorial Advisory Board and Correspondent of the International Construction Law Review. He is a practising arbitrator and a Fellow and of the Singapore Institute of Arbitrators (SIArb).

Dr Chan has written eleven books as both sole and joint author. His latest books are (a) Statutory Adjudication in Singapore, Thomson 2008 and (b) Asia Pacific Construction Law Casebook 2008, LexisNexis 2010. He has contributed to journals like the International Construction Law Review and Building and Construction Law journal. He also writes regularly in the newsletter of the SIArb.

Dr Chan has also delivered more than 200 conference/seminar papers and conducted numerous in-house training programmes on matters pertaining to standard form contracts and other areas of construction law and dispute resolution including arbitration.
