Lay Kuan is currently the Assistant Director of the Centre for Construction IT.

He is mainly involved in providing BIM implementations and consulting services to clients in the Architectural, Engineering and Construction Industry. This includes helping clients develop their modeling processes and standards, through providing industry experience and sharing best practices in Revit modeling and library creation. Paul has been involved in key projects with major companies like Main Contractors and large Architectural firms. Prior to this, Paul has worked for Chevron as a Cost Engineer/CAD Designer. Paul has been using various 3D CAD technologies since the start of his career.

Ben Thum is the self-titled Innovation Director of SIACAD Pte Ltd, a commercial arm of the Singapore Institute of Architects. He graduated as an architect from University Technology Malaysia. After practising for 5 years, he decided to pursue his passion for software development. He spent 15 years in software development, experimenting with various aspects of IT ranging from assembly code programming to non-linear digital video editing.
