

## **SIA EVENT:**

## **ECOLOGICAL URBAN ARCHITECTURE: TAKING STOCK OF GREEN**

Singapore has, over the last couple of years, become a model city for green architecture in Southeast Asia and developers, architects, and builders are becoming increasingly aware of the need for the built environment to embody principles of sustainability. At the same time, "going green" is undergoing a shift of focus from quantitative measures toward principle-based, design-oriented interactive interventions.

Dr Thomas Schroepfer will speak about his latest book titled "Ecological Urban Architecture: Qualitative Approaches to Sustainability" that analyses this trend by looking at projects in Singapore and beyond and identifies fields in which architectural and urban designers can use their creative skills and methods to achieve sustainable results on an urban scale. Ecological Urban Architecture includes a number of contributions by leading international experts in the fields of architecture, landscape architecture, engineering, and design theory, among them Achim Menges of Stuttgart University Institute for Computational Design, Federico Parolotto of Mobility in Chain, Eduardo Rico of Groundlab London, Sheila Kennedy of MIT, and Matthias Sauerbruch of Sauerbruch Hutton, who provide in-depth information on the complexity of ecodesign in urban environments and emphasize the need for new sensibilities in disciplinary and trans-disciplinary thinking processes.



Dr Thomas Schroepfer is Associate Professor and Programme Director of Architectural Design at the newly established Singapore University of Technology and Design (SUTD), founded in collaboration with Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT).

Prior to joining SUTD in 2011, he was Associate Professor of Architecture at Harvard University's Graduate School of Design. He has published extensively on the topic of ecology and design and his work has been exhibited internationally, including in Singapore's Urban Redevelopment Authority's Architecture and Urban Design Excellence Programme (AUDE).

Schroepfer is the author of an ongoing series of articles published in Singapore Architect Magazine on the same topic and is currently working with the Lee Kuan Yew Centre for Innovative Cities on a new book on dense and green building typologies.
