Synopsis

Grimshaw's work is founded on analysis and exploration rather than the imposed application of a pre-ordained stylistic architectural solution. This method explores design in a much more organic way, and produces designs that are informed by the same laws that control and shape the world around us.

Grimshaw's studio is a place of innovation, invention and imagination - a place where the atmosphere is more that of a laboratory or think-tank than of a typical architecture office. This group boldly engages in design from first principles, and their solutions are often unexpected, but, once understood, resonantly clear.

This lecture will trace an evolution of thinking from early pioneering industrial projects to recent complex infrastructure work. It will expand upon and explore in detail the themes presented in Grimshaw's recent exhibition at the URA Centre – issues including Climate Change, Energy, Waste, Water, Food, Consumption, Land Management and Ecosystems.

Speaker Profiles



Andrew Whalley is Grimshaw's Deputy Chairman. He has been an instrumental part of Grimshaw since the earliest days of the practice, and has been Director in Charge of a range of diverse projects ranging from infrastructure projects to performing arts buildings.

His award-winning projects include the International Terminal at Waterloo, The Eden Project in Cornwall, the redevelopment of Paddington Station in London and the Experimental Media and Performing Arts Center in New York.



Keith is Grimshaw's Managing Partner for International Operations. Since joining the practice in 1995 Keith has led a number of award winning projects including Paddington Station, London; Fundacion Caixa Galicia, Spain; National Space Centre, Leicester; and Southern Cross Station in Melbourne.

He has set up Grimshaw's Australian business and guides all of its work in the region, and focuses on key masterplanning projects in Europe.
