New FIRE CODE 2013: Impacts On Your Practices



General Synopsis

In three (3) months time, the new edition of Fire Code 2013 will take effects on 15 July 2013. There are several new as well as revised requirements that will have very significant impacts on the site planning, layout designs, building efficiency, construction program and projects costs.

The building professionals must have a clear and complete picture of the inter-related changes of the requirements of Fire Code 2013, before they could make the strategic decision of whether to accelerate the preparation of fire safety plans and submit the plans to FSSD for approval before 15 July 2013.

Knowing what are the changes in Fire Code 2013 is not good enough, you need to know how to apply them in the Residential designs and Hotel Occupancy designs, as well as how the building security designs could be holistically considered together with Fire Code requirements.

1st Presentation Topic “The Impact Of Fire Code 2013 On Residential Design”
Mdm Eng Yew Hoon – Principal Architect of EZY Architects

Profile:

Mdm Eng is the principal architect of EZY architects and a Registered Inspector . She has been actively involved in SIA Regulation Codes & Standards Committee since 1993.

Over the years, she represented SIA in many committees involving revision of various Codes such as Code of Practice for pollution control, revision of Building Control Regulations, CP26, CP72 ,Fire Code Review Committees for the Fire Code 2002 2007 and the currently released Fire Code 2013. She was also involved in the review of the recently released Fire Safety In Rapid Transit Systems 2012 and CP1 with Spring Singapore.

She is the Deputy Chairperson of SIA- FSSD & Security Sub Committee and is currently appointed by Ministry Of Home Affairs as the Chairwoman of the Fire Safety Appeals Advisory Board.

She has recently received the STAR CUSTOMER AWARD awarded by SCDF.

Synopsis:

With the launching of the Fire Code 2013 in March 2013, some QPs may have difficulty understanding the changes in the Clauses, let alone in their application.

However, in reality there is no stopping the implementation of the Code, and the impact on design is immediate. Mdm Eng would like to help QPs understand the changes by extracting the relevant new or revised clauses that affect the residential design, and illustrate its interpretation and application through some case studies.

Mr Song Yew Kee – Associate Director (Technical) of DP Architects Pte Ltd

Profile:

Since 1987, Mr Song Yew Kee has been representing Singapore Institute of Architects, working very closely with Fire Safety & Shelter Department in various committees to review the several editions of Fire Code, including the Fire Code 2013; to prepare illustration handbooks; to draft the performance-based Fire Code and to review household & storey shelter's requirements. He is currently the Council Member of SIA CY2013/2014 and Chairman of RCS-Fire Safety & Security Sub-Committee, representing SIA in FSSD Standing Committee and appointed as a member of the Fire Safety Appeals Advisory Board under Ministry of Home Affairs.

Mr Song holds a Master of Fire Safety Engineering Degree, registered as a Fire Safety Engineer and a Registered Inspector. He actively representing SIA in Spring Singapore's Technical Committee for Lifts, Escalators & Passenger Conveyors (SS 550, CP 15 & SS 209); and Working Groups for Fire Doors (SS 332) and Fire Sprinkler System (CP 52).

Mr Song was nominated by SCDF to receive the Public Service PS21 Star Customer Award in 2012 to recognize his significant contributions as customers to Public Service.

Profiles:

Dr. Vickery will not be drawn on how long he has been in practice in Singapore, although he concedes to measurement of his professional life here in versions of the Fire Code. He notes that he has been in architectural practice in Singapore for a span of at least five versions of the Code. Meanwhile, his service as a member of the SIA Fire Safety and Security Committee has been marked by the introduction of two of those versions. He still has copies of them all – somewhere.

Mr Benedict Lee has been in the professional circle for the last 30 years and has been actively involved with many regulatory bodies. His contribution presently involves in the Fire Safety & Security Committee of SIA and representative in the FSSD waiver panel. He involved and participated in the preparation of the PWD code and presently represented in SPRING as the Deputy chairman of the Technical committee in the revision and preparation of Singapore Standards/Code of Practice.
