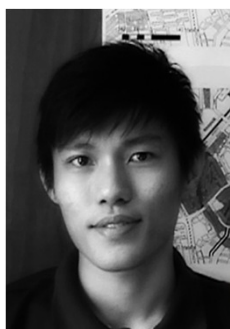


SIA Event:

In this sharing session, the winners for Singapore Construction Productivity Week (SCPW) BIM 2012 will be invited to share their competition experiences as well as how they have been incorporating BIM application in their projects. 1st Speaker: Mr Garvin Goh

Garvin graduated in Project and Facilities Management from the National University of Singapore with a BSC (Hons) and holds a Specialist Diploma in BIM (Merit) from the BCA Academy.

He has been actively involved in the field of BIM during his undergraduate studies, taking part in international competitions such as the BuildASIA Live in Korea and the BuildingSMART BIMBuzz Competitions in 2011 before embarking into the professional industry in RSP Architects Planners & Engineers (Pte) Ltd.

Garvin is a key member of RSP's team of BIM Coordinators, involved in the strategic implementation and execution of BIM in the company and the projects.

Topic: "Ready-Steady-Proficient": A BIM Competition Strategy

During the BCA SCPW 2012, RSP took part in the inaugural BIM Competition under the Architectural Industry category and clinched the title as the Overall Winner as well as the Best Team for using BIM for Publication and Presentation.

2006, she undertook a new self-driven transition into BIM, quickly establishing herself as a self-motivated, highly skilled and adaptable individual. She was invited to educate, mentor & lead Woodhead PTY Ltd through their BIM journey travelling through-out Australia, India, & Singapore.

2011, she was invited to move Singapore. She has continued her reputation as an industry leader speaking to local organizations, authorities, industry events, seminars, education facilities & International conferences.

2012, Laura joined DPA & has been instrumental in establishing corporate BIM protocol, process & procedures. She has established & coordinates the internal training program for staff to assist with the migration from 2D to BIM.

We will explore our BIM journey by establishing a constant BIM communication internally, education for all our staff, acquisition of BIM experts, and keeping up the momentum in a forward direction. We will share lessons learnt, and key factors to your success in not only implementing BIM, but maintaining leading edge BIM best practices. We will talk about the challenges we need to overcome and the benefits we achieve.



3rd Speaker: Mr Kuan Chee Yung
Senior Vice President, CPG

Chee Yung has over seventeen years of extensive architectural & planning experience, including campus and township master planning, research-intensive institutional, resort design, industrial, MRT station upgrades, waterfront developments, commercial and residential projects.

He picked up Autodesk REVIT in 2009 and has completed the Changi General Hospital 10 year master plan in 2010 using BIM as a planning tool and Seletar Business Aviation Complex design and submission using BIM the same year. He is now fully harnessing the power of BIM by coordinating his current MD1 education and research complex in NUS from schematic design to submission, tender and now construction coordination drawings as well as utilizing BIM for all overseas competition and design consultancy projects. Recently his team has won a 2 million sqft incubator complex in China in 7 days and completed a 187 acre waterfront master plan with video flythrough in 3 days, all using BIM technology for multi-disciplinary collaboration.

Chee Yung will be supported by team technical experts Cheng Wei and Teah Soo Hong of CPGreen.
