PUB Updates on Amendments to the Code of Practice on Surface Water Drainage (2013)

PUB has announced revisions to the Code of Practice on Surface Water Drainage as part of its holistic stormwater management strategy for Singapore. The changes include a new requirement for developers to implement on-site measures to slow down surface runoff and reduce stormwater peak flows into the public drainage system. Besides this new clause, there are also administrative amendments made to some existing clauses to enhance their implementation. These revisions will take effect from 1 June 2013, with a six-month grace period for the implementation of the new clause on reduction of peak flow from 1 Jan 2014.

He oversees the overall Development Control/Building Plan submission and catchment planning for Singapore. Prior to his current appointment, he has been with the Best Sourcing Department where he oversees the implementation of NEWater Pipeline, Water Reclamation Plant, ABC Waters and Drainage Projects across the island.

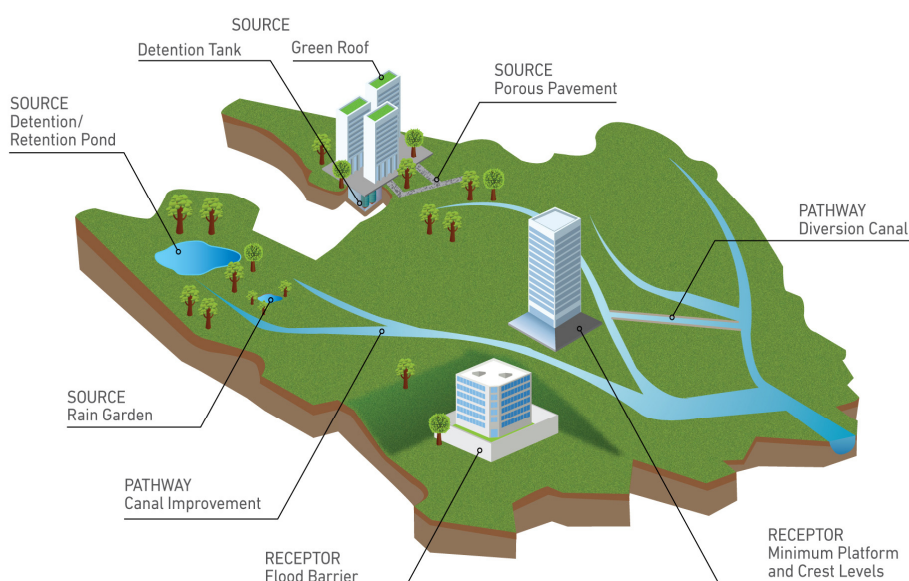
TOPIC: On-site Detention
