Presentation will cover a brief introduction of the characteristics of ETFE building skins in the areas of structural behaviour, light transmission, insulation, acoustics, fire engineering, environmental modification, discussion on advantages and disadvantages compared to glass and its applications in construction in case studies such as ITE Central in Ang Mo Kio and Sportshub. The speaker will share the design process with fully utilisation of ETFE's characteristics and challenges encountered during the design development.

The 2nd speaker will present the wide applications of Terracotta Facade panels as a perfect match allowing architects to create their building design. Terracotta Facade panels blend urban tradition and materials with the latest technology in ventilated facades, offering the discerning architects the creative freedom to pursue and expand their designs. A key feature of these panels is the proprietary facade solutions. Water is moved away from building envelopes, using a ventilated system. 
