Since acquiring his diploma with a silver medal in 1994, James has been proactively engaging in the promotion for the Guild education programme and in encouraging existing Diploma holder to carry on with the Institute CPD programme with a view to increasing the number of Registered Architectural Ironmongers to serve the construction industry in Asia.
