Laser fused stainless structural profiles and shapes for the Architectural world

Laser fused sections are produced by welding individual material strip to make one complete section. The joints are created by powerful lasers without any filler material, producing very small weld seams. Most carbon- and stainless steel materials can be fused according to ASTM 1069, creating a monolithic structure up to 30mm thickness.

Architects today do not have to refer to the steel catalogue during designing, enabling them to think out of the box! With laser-fusion technology, the quality of the whole piece for visual appearances of weld seam are limited to 2 mm on the surface, resulting in perfect welds.

Due to the high welding speed and large welding depth caused by deep penetration technology, a product of higher process stability and productivity will be achieved as compared to traditional arc welding. Stainless steel is 100% recyclable, is a green product with low carbon foot print, has a very low life cycle cost and has a very long life span.


