Re-engaging with Education: Flexible Learning Centres in Australia

Australia has in the order of 60,000 young people who, for various reasons, have become disengaged from the mainstream education system. This presentation will look at several projects that Fulton Trotter Architects have undertaken for "Youth +" to address this issue.

Prior to her joining MKPL Architects in April 2007, she was the Senior Vice President of Education Division, CPG Consultants Pte Ltd where she led a multi-disciplinary team focused in the design and development of education facilities, including K-12 schools, student housing, universities, research laboratories etc

Pit Li's passion is in the planning and design of innovative learning environments, seeing each project as a unique opportunity to test new ideas and create conducive and nurturing learning spaces with a strong sense of place.

Exploring a High Rise School Typology

The presentation discusses the design implications of a high-rise school. The key case study is the new Singapore International School in Hong Kong - This project involves the adaptive re-use and partial rebuilding of an existing urban school in the hilly terrain of Hong Kong Island - transforming a 20-year old utilitarian public school facility into a contemporary learning environment. The extremely constrained conditions (small site area, undulating terrain, limited site access, limitations of existing structures etc) offer a unique opportunity to explore new strategies for a High-Rise School in the City, exploring the vertical stacking of program and space to derive an appropriate high-rise urban school typology.
