- Nutrients trees need nutrients, and soil in the vault may get depleted?
- Tree stability will my tree get blown around?
- Engineering I want to use space beneath pavements for the treepit, how is this done to satisfy engineers?
- Treepit opening what are the pros and cons of tree grilles vs soft planted opening in pavement? Relative to tree size?
- Vandalism Is it necessary to protect the tree from wilful damage? What are the options
- If making a tree vault beneath pavement what shape and depth is best?
- Cost some projects have greater cost constraints than others, how keep this down?
- Design of tree vaults what are the main systems out there?
- Maintenance trees need ongoing maintenance, is this impacted by use of tree vaults?


Business interests include manufacturing and distribution businesses in Australia, and North America, and licensed manufacturing in United Kingdom.
