Speaker's profile:



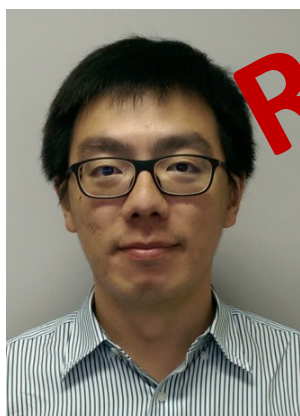
