

SG50 SIA Pioneer Architects Series of Lectures And Conversations: A Conversation With William S.W. Lim

William Lim is one of our distinguished pioneer Architects. He trained at the London AA and furthered his education at Harvard where he focussed on planning and housing. He was active in the early days of SIA and served as editor of the SIA Journal. Together with Lim Chong Keat, Chen Voon Fee, they formed Malayan Architects Co-partnership a pioneering Group Practice and their most notable work as a Partnership was the Singapore Conference Hall and Trade Union House at Shenton Way. Together with many like-minded professionals he started SPUR, a multidisciplinary group dedicated to developing ideas on the planning of the Singapore physical environment. It's most notable contribution among many ideas was in urging the move of the Singapore Airport to Changi rather than to expand the existing Paya Lebar airport then being planned.

After the MAC dissolved in 1967 he formed Design Partnership which later morphed into DP Architects. After that he established William Associates. He writes a lot due to his intellectual interest in Theory and Social issues. His social concerns led him to pioneer Architectural Heritage Conservation which took off after his publication of "Pastel Portraits". He also started the Singapore Heritage Society and was Chairman for many years.

His intellectual and social concerns led him to join the South East Asia Study Group with intellectuals from South East Asia and Japan. After his retirement he continued his writing, busy conference schedule, teaching in China, organising AA Asia an Architectural Forum with a research agenda. He can be said to be Singapore's distinguished Activist Architect from whom much can be learnt. One of his greatest contributions was his mentoring and adopting of young architects into the wider world of knowledge and social contacts which he very generously shared with them. He is thus, the "Great Conventor" indeed.

As a community of Architects SIA has the privilege to host this Conversation with William Lim for him to share his vast experience with the audience. The format of the Conversation will be informal through a selected panel of discussants who will lead in picking his brains on his vast experience and knowledge both of Singapore and also internationally. After the panel discussion, we will open the discussion to the floor. The entire conversation will be Video-taped for the record.

The Conversation will be moderated by Tay Kheng Soon.
