## SIA Professional Knowledge Series: Designing Watertight Structures: Ways To Keep Water Out

Waterproofing typically accounts for 1-2% of a building project's overall construction cost. However, waterproofing failure and repair can be highly disruptive and very expensive. Furthermore, water infiltration does not solve itself and often gets worse until it is fully resolved. In the meantime, costly damage may already have been done to structure and finishing.
