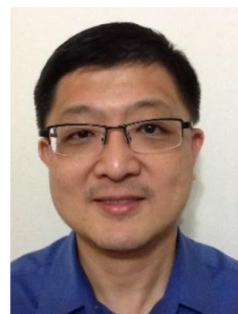

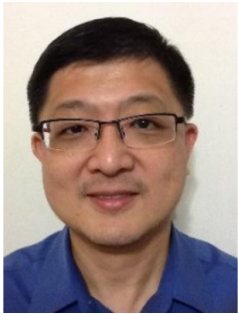

### TOPIC

**Looking under the bed: A practical approach for architects to meet new obligations and avoid the pitfalls under the DfS Regulations**

**BCS 3 is postponed**

Darren Benger is a Council member of SIA, and Chairperson of the SIA Design for Safety Taskforce. He was appointed to the task to represent SIA in the DfS Regulations Taskforce (as far as is reasonably practicable, prepare a design plan for the structure that eliminates all foreseeable design risks). Darren sits on two of the taskforce sub-groups, (i) the design for safety group, and (ii) the competency and capability group. He is also a member of the SIA in the WSH Council's WSH (Construction & Landscaping) sub-committee, in which Darren actively participated in implementing the 'Design for Safety in Buildings and Structures'. Darren is also a Trainer for the SIA Design for Safety course and has insights into the purposes and intents of the DfS Regulations, and will enlighten fellow architects his thoughts on the background, pitfalls and good practice approaches to the new Regulations.

### Synopsis

The Workplace Safety and Health (Design for Safety) Regulations 2015 were gazetted on 10th July 2015 and come into operation on 1 August 2016. The Regulations impose duties on "designers", defined as "the person who prepares a design plan relating to a structure [which includes buildings]" - i.e. including architects. The principal duty of a designer is to, "as far as it is reasonably practicable, prepare a design plan for the structure that eliminates all foreseeable design risks." This is a serious and daunting obligation.

This course session examines the design-for-safety scheme under the Regulations, and focuses on how "designers" can go about meeting their design obligations and avoid pitfalls.
