Gieto Sugianto received his Master degree in Architecture in 1985 from Rheinisch - Westphalian Technological University of Aachen, Germany, and was a recipient of various categories of Design Awards in limited and nationwide Students' Design Competitions. Prior to joining Architects 61 in 1990, Gieto had the opportunity to work in renowned architecture practice of Heinz Bienefeld and Gottfried Boehm in Cologne, Germany.

With close to 30 years of diverse experience in design, Gieto is instrumental in transforming Architects 61 into one of the

Corporate Design firms in Singapore. His passion for design has led his team to win numerous limited Design Competitions and Awards: Winner of SIA Architectural Heritage Award (PAHQ and Tan Chin Tuan Mansion at 42 Cairnhill), SIA Architectural Design Award (PAHQ and Ardmore three), BCA Best Buildable Design Award (the Heeren), World Architecture Festival Award (Rochor and Little India MRT station), ASEAN Energy Award (Tampines Grande), and others.

Gieto is an associate member of SIA and has conducted numerous seminars for BCA regarding External Cladding in 2003. He has strong interest in promoting local architectural design education and in reaching out to the future designers from University and Polytechnics.

LIM Wee Loon is a Registered Architect with the Singapore Board of Architects. He received his Master degree in Architecture from the National University of Singapore and was a recipient of numerous Student Design Awards. Upon graduation in 2009, Wee Loon joined Architects 61 and was made an Associate in 2014.

In the course of his practice, Wee Loon honed his skills through rigorous design and research processes in Residential, Commercial and Institutional building typologies. He is a strong advocate of Environmental Sustainability, and numerous projects that he has been involved in have received Green Mark Platinum Award. He was also a delegate at the International Energy Forum 2014 which took place in Bressanone, Italy.

Wee Loon also has strong interests in engaging budding designers of the future generation, and was part of the Crit Panel for URA CUBE 2015.
