Synopsis:

Francis & Donovan apprenticed under Mun Summ and Richard Hassell at WOHA before forming FDAT. The training provided a substantial foundation for the pairs' subsequent endeavors; the pair discuss their roots, the experience of starting up and growing the studio, and their approach to design and the practice of architecture.

The studio has undertaken a diverse range of projects in various stages of development, ranging from interiors, detached houses, shophouses to larger scale residential and hospitality projects. They will present selected work and examine key studio tenets such as ordering principles, environmental responsiveness, issues of context and identity; providing insight into the thought and decision making process and how the studio balances ideas and practicalities.

Francis Goh graduated with first-class honors from University of Western Australia winning the Cox Howlett & Bailey Woodland Architectural Award. He has also been a guest critic at the Singapore Polytechnic.

Donovan Soon graduated with a Master of Architecture from the National University of Singapore, winning the Lee

Kuan Yew Gold Medal, Board of Architects Prize and Gold Medal, the Architecture Alumni Association Book Prize, also winning the top prize in the BOA registration examinations. He has also been a studio master at his alma mater.

As MOD's Founder and Director of Design, Colin has been named Designer of the Year by International Design Awards USA 2010, and is a two-time recipient of Singapore's highest design accolade, the President's Design Award. He is also a two-time Grand Prize Winner of the Gold Key Award, the highest international hospitality accolade, named Hong Kong Perspective's '40 under 40 architects' and Marcus Corporation Foundation Prize 2007 'emerging architect with potential for greatness'. Recognized as "Rising Star in Architecture" by Monocle, Colin Seah has been invited by the Singapore Tourism Board to redefine Singapore as a destination for 2020 and beyond.
