Mr Jean Francois Milou, Studio Milou Singapore

Jean-François Milou is the Principal Architect and lead partner, Studio Milou, Paris & Singapore. Studio Milou beat out 110 entries in winning the competition to design the National Art Gallery Singapore (due to open in 2015, the 50th Anniversary of the independence of Singapore). A graduate of the Ecole Nationale Supérieure

des Beaux-Arts in Paris, in addition to his architectural project, Milou has worked as a consultant to UNESCO, and for the French Government on projects in India, Nepal, Indonesia and Georgia. Studio Milou Architecture specializes in the adaptive reuse of historical and heritage buildings while respecting their historical fabric, meaning and surroundings.

Mr Mok Wei Wei, W Architects

Mok Wei Wei is presently Managing Director of W Architects Pte Ltd.

Mok's numerous architectural projects have received critical acclaim both locally and internationally and have been featured in many regional and international publications.

In recognition of his contributions to Singapore's architectural scene, he was conferred the President's Design Award in 2007, the nation's highest honour for design.

Mok is a board member of the Preservation of Sites and Monuments from 1999 and is currently its Deputy Chairman. He is a board member of the Urban Redevelopment Authority since 2006, and is a

board member of the Singapore Land Authority from 2015.

In recognition of his contribution to public service, he was conferred the Public Service Medal (PBM) in 2014.
