

SIA Professional Knowledge Series: Understand the Meaning of Going Green

Singapore has been emerging as a model of green building for planners and developers across much of the Asia-Pacific region by adopting innovative architectural design and energy-saving technologies. The promotion of green buildings has the potential to produce large energy savings and make polluted cities more habitable while partially mitigating the impacts of climate change.

The BCA Green Mark Scheme is one such initiative which promotes sustainability and provides benchmarking by incorporating internationally recognised best practices in environmental design and performance. The revised version, Green Mark 2015, would drive a more holistic approach for building sustainability, with greater emphasis on features such as a building's life cycle, smart technologies and wellbeing of occupants.

The Singapore Green Labelling Scheme (SGLS) has been an integral component of the Green Mark Scheme, facilitating the adoption of sustainable products within the built environment. Other than minimizing environmental footprint of a building life cycle, utilising green products in building construction enables more efficient management of resources and gain in market value. With greater awareness and interest in environmental issues, there is also increased motivation for organisations to operate in an environmentally responsible and sustainable way.
