The role and operative model of the Architecture Practice has been a neglected topic. The exceptionally successful firms are either small boutique studios or mega corporation-like establishments. While the education of an Architect offers training in creative design and analytical skillsets, it tends not to address the reality of running a business. This is not to say that commercial concerns outweigh creative priorities – but rather suggests that financial rigour and design quality are in fact mutually beneficial.

The talk will cover Frven's concept of the Design Enterprise which he has developed over the past 6 years through personal research. Presented using diagrammatic models to suggest the operative modes of sustainable design-office typologies, the content is intended to question whether business and architecture can be the same thing.

The contents will be illustrated via a juxtaposition and comparison of projects that Frven has been involved in both in Singapore (at Surbana) and in London (at Adjaye Associates). The talk will be beneficial for practitioners who are interested in the discourse between design-focussed and financial-focussed modes of operating.

Frven Lim is a Singapore registered Architect who is currently practising in the London office of Adjaye Associates. Prior to moving to the United Kingdom in late 2015, he worked for 17 years in Singapore (at HDB until 2003 and subsequently at Surbana). He has worked at Director level for the past five years, leading and managing both the design and practice realms. Over his career, he has advocated the concept of "Design Enterprise" and believes strongly in the practice of architecture as a design-driven business.

Now at Adjaye Associates, Frven is managing a number of the London office's projects, including 70-73 Piccadilly (a £600M project opposite the Ritz Hotel in central London) and Rwanda Paediatric Cancer Hospital.

His achievements include the AUDE "20 under 45" in 2010 as well as several design publications (whilst at Surbana) including the widely circulated "Housing People". In 2014, the fourth book titled "Project 2050" was launched and presented at the World Architecture Festival. Frven is also the author of an essay published alongside the Singapore Design Council's exhibition titled "1000+ Singapores" held at Paris' city hall during the summer of 2015.

He gained a distinction for his Masters degree in Landscape Urbanism, and a graduate Diploma from the Architectural Association School of Architecture, and was awarded a first-class Honors degree from the University of Manchester.
